



- Milwood Neighborhood Association will provide \$841 in professional services for survey work and design of signs and \$6,010 of in-kind materials for signage and plans.
- City of Austin will be responsible for trail repairs at 4 different locations, installation of mile marker signs, and installation of large and small signs around the park.
- Milwood Neighborhood Association will be responsible for organizing volunteers to clear rock off trail, landscape the pool entrance and for park maintenance events and cleanups.
- Letters of support were received from Milwood Neighborhood Association, Northwood N.A., Summit Elementary and Girl Scout Troop 40.

## **Quality of Life Enhancements & Incorporation of City Initiatives**

- Addressing the hole on the trail will increase biker safety and allow access for strollers.
- Trail improvements will allow students from the nearby elementary school to keep using this trail for their science classes.
- Improves public health by providing a safe route through Balcones District Park for recreational purposes.
- Project complements the work of the Urban Trails Master Plan.
- Increase connectivity between neighborhoods and from neighborhoods to parks and greenways through the use of sidewalks, bicycle lanes, multi-use paths, and trails. (Imagine Austin CFS P42)
- Increase the safety and amenities of parks. trails, playground, bike paths, and creation centers. (Imagine Austin P 206)
- Investing in accessible walking and biking networks and open space will provide residents increased opportunities for outdoor exercise as part of their daily routines. (Imagine Austin - P 206)
